Among the world's best schools, Cardiff Sixth Form College stands out as unique. Specially designed for ambitious, able, hardworking students, the College offers world-class teaching alongside exceptional facilities to help students win places at the best universities in the world at its two campuses in Cardiff and Cambridge.

Rated the top private school in the UK, the college has been number one in national A-level results for over a decade, with 68.2% achieving all A* grades, 94% A*-A and 99.6% A*-B at our Cardiff campus in 2025. We encourage students to reach beyond their academic horizons and strive for high achievement: This year 81% won places at a QS top 100 university, 35% went onto G5 universities and 55% to Russell Group. 6% of the cohort gained Oxbridge places and 48% have gone onto study medicine and healthcare related courses.

With over 40 different nationalities among our student body, we are also a truly international community of learners.

The college provides an excellent bridge between school and university, with pupils encouraged to develop independent learning skills and a mature approach to both study and day-to-day living.

ACADEMIC SUBJECTS

Cardiff Sixth Form College offers students the perfect academic programme for admission to top universities. Our academic programme is built on a focused approach to A levels, the internationally respected standard for school-leaving qualifications.

A-LEVELS

Students at Cardiff Sixth Form College get the chance to specialise in four subjects of their choice in the first year (AS) of Sixth Form and continue with three or four subjects in the second (A2) year. Students should choose four subjects they are good at and enjoy.

Some university courses require particular A-level subjects to have been studied as preparation, such as Chemistry for Medicine (Maths and Biology preferred but not required), or and Maths, Further Maths and Physics for Engineering, so do consider this in addition when picking your subjects.

ACADEMIC EXTENSION

Students at Cardiff Sixth Form College go far beyond A-levels in their studies. Here we aim to extend our students' knowledge of their subjects often beyond the curriculum through extension projects, research, TED Talks, online courses and podcasts to fuel a passion for their subjects. We want our students to be able to think for themselves, to understand and enjoy their subjects at a deeper level, to be encouraged to explore areas of individual interest and to be independent, self-sufficient young adults, ready for university life, with a genuine care and interest in others and the wider world.

CAREERS DEVELOPMENT

Under careers development – Students at Cardiff Sixth Form College develop careers and life skills through our careers and higher education programme. We arrange extensive work placements and observations and volunteering, connect our students with leading employers and provide career skills workshops all designed to help students, well beyond the academic curriculum, to develop their knowledge and skills in preparation for their chosen degree and career.

IELTS PREPARATION

International English Language Test System (IELTS) exams often feature as part of UK university entrance requirements. Cardiff Sixth Form College provides exam specialists and experienced English teachers to ensure that students understand the test and are properly prepared to maximise their IELTS scores.



GCSEs

GCSEs, offered at our Cardiff campus, are the first formal academic qualifications undertaken by all pupils in the UK specifically designed to:

- Prepare pupils for Sixth Form study.
- Deliver a foundation of knowledge and skills to support excellent study habits at A Level.
- Provide appropriate levels of personal understanding of A-level choices, best suited to the individual student's strengths and interests which facilitate future university course choice.

UK universities make offers based on a complex variety of evidence. GCSEs are important, externally assessed subjects which provide a clear indicator to universities of the academic quality and potential of students during their application. Universities take them into consideration when making offers.

As the top academic school in the UK, Cardiff Sixth Form College is able to offer two pathways for students wishing to study GCSEs as Pre-A Level qualifications enabling us to best fit our provision to the needs of our pupils and give them an outstanding and excellent preparation for Sixth Form study at A Level.

A UNIQUE CURRICULUM

Developing career and life skills is central to all education at Cardiff Sixth Form College.

As well as aiming for top A-level grades and universities, the college helps students build management and project skills, teamwork, confidence, and a healthy mindset. Our teaching approach also places considerable emphasis on independent learning – to look beyond simple answers and demonstrate a passion for knowledge and discovery.

ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

- **Critical Speaking:** In this course, students are encouraged to explore questions from multiple perspectives in order to understand how different disciplines construct and convey knowledge. They examine beliefs, assumptions, and opinions against facts and learn to understand logic and logical argumentation.
- **Extended Project Qualification:** A research project based on a student's own interests, the EPQ is an exciting opportunity for students to take charge of their own learning. The end product is generally a 5,000-word essay, and the process of planning, researching, and presenting enables students to talk with authority about their chosen subject at interview.
- Architecture and art are supported in preparing an Art Portfolio. This can be subject-specific or draw on a variety of artistic media. Students will be given advice and feedback as well as help with presentation and content by our Head of Art.

ENRICHMENT AND SUPER CURRICULAR

The College also runs numerous 'super-curricular' clubs and societies, which help develop knowledge and understanding in a variety of different disciplines as well as skills such as:

- **Effective communication:** Lessons on public speaking, MUN and debating.
- **Leadership:** Students have a number of options to develop their leadership skills – such as becoming Prefects, Student Leaders, or part of the Student Council and committee members for major school events and activities.
- **Entrepreneurship:** Involvement in business workshops and Young Enterprise Scheme
- **Mindfulness:** Workshops and discussions on mental health and Resilience, as well as yoga and pilates classes.
- **Living Skills:** These include cooking classes, money management, washing, and ironing – and the school MasterChef Competition.
- **Academic Skills:** Research skills and referencing preparing students for university progression.

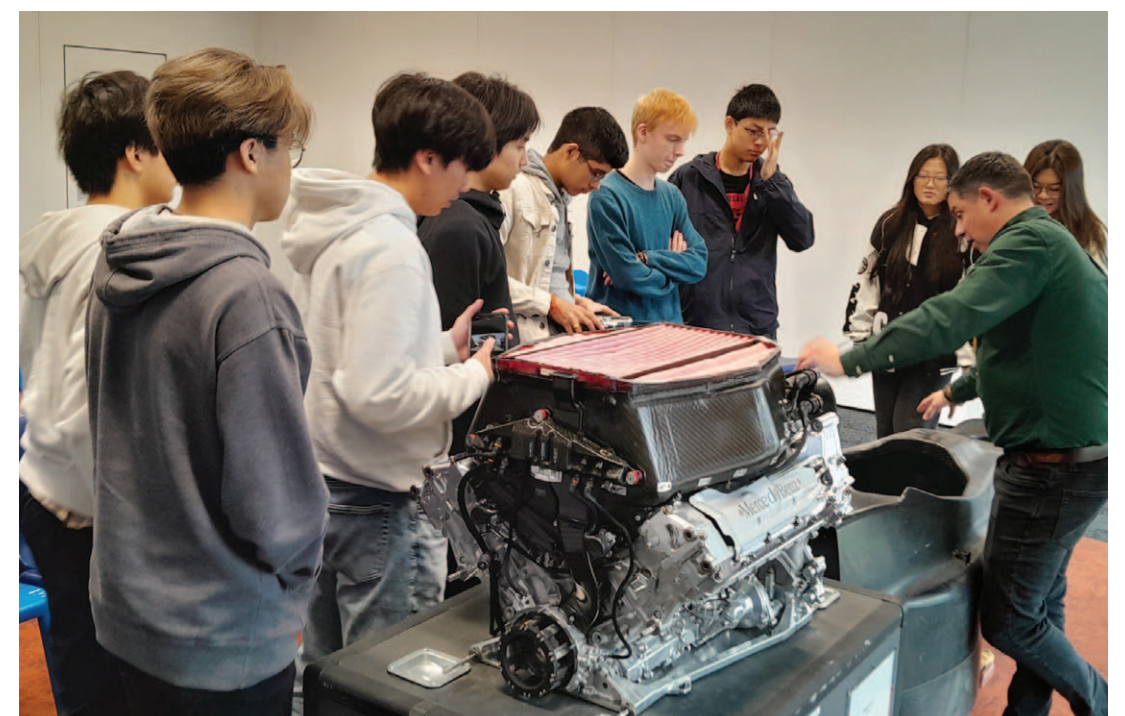
THE CAMBRIDGE EDGE

A specialised programme for STEM students at our Cambridge campus offering a world-class super curricular offer which taps into the vibrant academic and technological life of Cambridge.

Activities including:

- Cambridge University lectures by world leading Professors and Nobel Prize Winners – 20 attended this year including 'What Causes Depression', Quantum Collisions' Economics to Predict Covid Cases' and 'Cancer Immortality and Christology'.
- Work experience from top employers at businesses such as Cambridge University Teaching Hospitals, Speech and Language Work Observation, Judge Business School, ARM Future of Computing, Addenbrooks Hospital, UK Atomic Energy Authority and Imperial College Healthcare Trust.
- Bespoke Cambridge University alumni mentoring programme.
- Trips to world-class scientific and engineering sites such as Silvestone Racetrack, Rutherford Laboratories, Bletchley Park, ARM Chips, UK Atomic Energy Authority.
- Visits to universities.
- Talks by leading experts including SGU, UCL, A-List US Applications and Study Options.
- Workshops and Career Skill Development including Freud and Dreams Workshop, Institute of Astronomy, National Museum of Computing.

A WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

Learning begins in the classroom...but doesn't end there.

Students at Cardiff Sixth Form College are encouraged to participate in a wide range of activities that teach core skills and help them plan their way forward through education and careers.

WORK OBSERVATIONS AND CAREER EXPERIENCES

Work observation and volunteering are key advantages when applying to top universities and we allocate two weeks every October and February for students to gain this experience. We help students gain placements at a variety of professional workplaces such as GP surgeries, nursery schools, hospitals, veterinary clinics, law firms, financial institutions, and engineering companies. In addition, we work with our Dukes Education sister company InvestIn (www.investin.org) to offer our students immersive career experiences.

INTERNATIONAL CITIZENSHIP EXPERIENCE

Cardiff Sixth Form College also runs the International Citizenship Experience (ICE) in international destinations such as India, Malaysia, Nepal, Tanzania and Europe every July – a unique programme designed to give student work experience and observation, team building, leadership, and cultural awareness.

UNIVERSITY PREPARATION

Our support programme gives students the best chance to achieve their potential.

Cardiff Sixth Form College works tirelessly to support students with their university applications. Our preparation programme covers every aspect of university admission and runs for the full two years of Sixth Form. Specific measures include:

- One-to-one careers interviews, tailored advice and target setting
- The UCAS process/personal statement guidance
- Study skills and mock interview practice
- Timetabled preparation for admissions tests (ESAT, UCAT, LNAT, TSA, STEP and other Oxford and Cambridge admissions tests)
- Group discussions and practical workshops
- Subject-specific talks by experts, including university lecturers and Admissions Tutors
- Curriculum-based trips to enrich subject and career knowledge
- Workshops from Dukes Education's Oxbridge, Medical and US Applications services
- University Open Days where students meet university admissions teams
- Guidance on the Common Application process (for US universities and colleges) and international university preparation (e.g. for Hong Kong, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and European universities)
- Ongoing support from Cardiff Sixth Form College's successful alumni

OXBRIDGE

Students of exceptional academic ability are likely to consider applying to Oxford or Cambridge and will require specialist preparation. Our programme for Oxbridge applicants includes:

- We run additional classes in STEP
- Interview training with Cardiff's Oxbridge Alumni and Dukes Education
- Oxbridge Applications experts
- Formal discussion of current affairs, news and events for interview
- Guidance on UCAS and Oxbridge college forms
- Tailored Oxbridge references

MEDICINE AND RELATED DEGREES

Students planning on applying for Medicine, Veterinary Science or Dentistry also receive specialist preparation. In addition to the Oxbridge programme above, this includes:

- Visits by medical school staff and current medical students
- Interview training with Cardiff Sixth Form College's Medical Alumni and Dukes Medical Applications
- Varied medical work observation placements
- Regular talks on topical issues in Healthcare
- Support from Cardiff Sixth Form College Alumni studying medical subjects at universities





SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AND SPORTS

Our students get involved in a huge range of activities and clubs for fun, relaxation and enrichment with a range of different and exciting opportunities at both Cardiff and Cambridge.

SPORT

The college encourages all its students to be fit and active. Health and leisure facilities include access to a gym and various other facilities in the local environment. Football, tennis, basketball, badminton, table tennis and netball matches are played between college Houses, with some fixtures organised against other schools – and if that’s not enough, we also stage an “Iron Man” fitness competition!

MUSIC

Many students are musical and the college can organise private music lessons for most instruments. The college runs a choir and an orchestra as well as several musical groups, and the music room with its range of instruments makes it easy for students to practice and make music together.

DRAMA

The Glee Club is an extremely popular society and puts on a major show every year at a local professional theatre: past productions include *Grease*, *Hairspray* and *Mulan*. Students are also encouraged to perform in dance, drama or music at at the Eisteddfod – an annual celebration of Welsh culture and the Arts - and The Cultural Event – the college’s major award ceremony of the year. In Cambridge students will have the opportunity to join and contribute to events as members of the wider college community.

DUKE OF EDINBURGH AWARD

Students can participate in the Duke of Edinburgh Award. They choose a service, physical and skills activities, go on an expedition and take part in a residential project, building confidence and challenging their beliefs about their own capabilities.

BOARDING AND STUDENT CARE

Moving away from home to study is an exciting prospect. We understand the importance of helping students enjoy their time here as they begin living away from home.

ACCOMMODATION

New students at Cardiff Sixth Form College are welcomed into our university-style boarding accommodation in both Cardiff and Cambridge. Our accommodation provides bright, well-equipped, en-suite rooms, superfast broadband, access to communal cooking facilities, relaxation and leisure areas and laundry facilities. Some of our houses also have music rooms and others communal gardens for students to relax in. CCTV and 24-hour security is also in constant operation.

MEALS

The college provides a range of excellent meals for students, where food is offered as a buffet selection and includes fresh vegetables, fruit, and dessert. The cuisine reflects the international nature of our student cohort, and includes halal, vegetarian, vegan, and special dietary requirements.

HOUSE EVENTS

Students enjoy a fun challenge with their House peers to win points for the House Cup competition. Other events held include the Fashion Show, Sports Day, MasterChef, inter-House sports competitions, writing competitions, and filmmaking events.

STUDENT WELFARE

Student welfare is our number one priority in everything we do. As well as full-time House Parents and assistants in each boarding house, there are also on-site medical centres in both our Cardiff and Cambridge campuses staffed by experienced healthcare practitioners. All students are registered with the UK National Health Service, giving them access to the local GP doctor as well as emergency hospital care.

NEW CAMPUS OPENING 2026

In September 2026 we are moving our Cardiff campus across town to Cardiff Bay, the waterfront area of the city. A stunning new campus is being built currently to include high quality, state of the art teaching space and boarding accommodation. It includes sensitively converting and restoring the Grade II listed Merchant Place and Cory's Building, adding a new building at the rear to provide teaching for 500 students, and purpose built accommodation of twin and single, ensuite bedrooms for 400 students.



ONE COLLEGE TWO CAMPUSES

Cardiff Sixth Form College has two campuses: Cardiff and Cambridge.

CARDIFF

Cardiff is Wales's capital, a modern and cosmopolitan city located around two and a half hours west of London. The city is commonly named one of the top places to live in the UK and offers charming Victorian arcades alongside ultra-modern shopping centres, attractive waterfront cafes, beautiful architecture, and international music and sport venues – all within walking distance of the college.



CAMBRIDGE

The university city of Cambridge is home to the world-renowned Cambridge University and its 31 colleges and is only 45 minutes from London. Stunning architecture, independent and boutique shopping, punting down the River Cam, annual festivals and events, numerous sporting opportunities and the ability to experience lectures at Cambridge University means Cambridge is the ideal student destination.

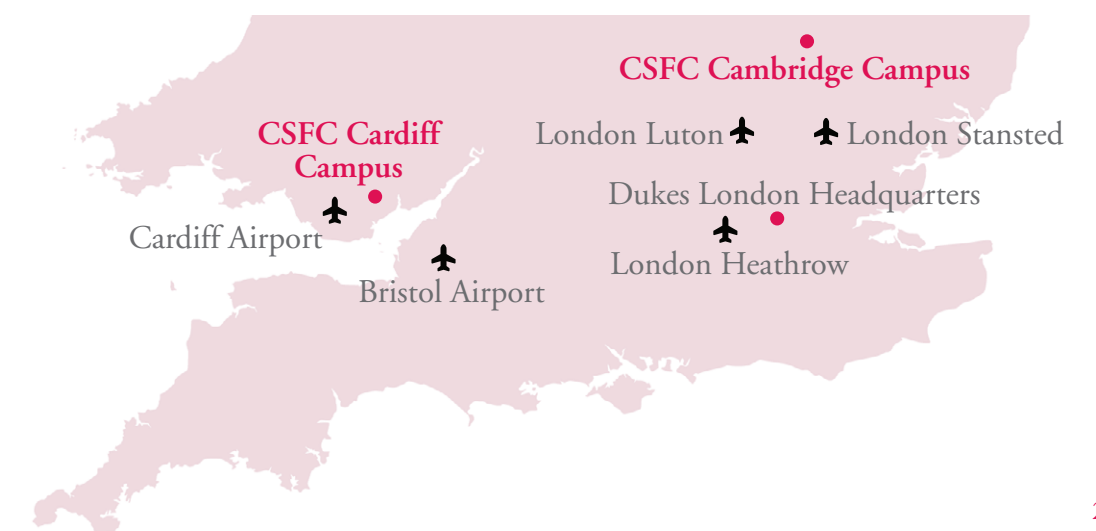
