FAQs: Bloomberg and Financial Trading at Guildhouse School

What is Bloomberg?

Bloomberg is a high tech, market moving, data driven, cross platform, information company designed to solve global problems.

Mr. Bloomberg (Michael Rubens Bloomberg) is an American businessman, politician, philanthropist, and author. He is the majority owner and co-founder of Bloomberg L.P. and was its CEO from 1981 to 2001 and again from 2014 to 2023.

Bloomberg has "The Terminal". The Terminal is the tool to analyse financial markets. Used by over 300,000 financial decision makers in industry, it is used to generate data and organise that data into action!

At Guildhouse School, we want students to have the best options for progression. Showing that you can use the Terminal and work with data is great to add to UCAS personal statements and use in later work life – it shows that you can handle, analyse and manipulate data!

What is financial trading?

The UFP Financial Trading course integrates extensive data access via the Bloomberg Terminal with foundational knowledge in business, economics, and mathematics. Enhanced by insights from real-life traders, this course synthesizes data, theory, and strategic applications essential for aspiring financial traders.

What is the Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC)?

The BMC, certified by Bloomberg, covers modules on economic indicators, currencies, fixed income, equities, and Environmental Social & Governance (ESG). While the course is self-paced, students in business, economics, or financial trading disciplines must adhere to specific deadlines.

Why use the terminal? Why use BMC?

Completing the BMC and its ESG components earns you a Bloomberg certification, demonstrating your commitment and capability beyond typical academic requirements. This distinction is especially valuable in UCAS personal statements as the BMC is usually only held by financial industry professionals.
