Three Core Elements

- The Theory of Knowledge asks students to reflect on the nature of knowledge and on how we know what we claim to know. It is assessed through an oral presentation and a 1,600word essay.
- An extended essay prepares students for the study skills required at university.
- Creativity, Activity and Service comprises arts and other activities, including sports, outdoor pursuits and community engagement, such as volunteering.
